Level 5-6 Classes

Required Core: 3 to 6 Ballet technique classes per week, 3 Pointe classes, 1 variation/repertoire class, 1 Contemporary/Modern class, and 1-3 alignment/conditioning classes. If taking only 3 ballet classes, students MUST choose to attend Mondays, and Saturdays and then choose their third ballet technique class on either Wednesday or Thursday. Students may add any extra classes free of additional charge to challenge themselves and improve faster. Taking additional classes at levels 1b through 4 always improves strength and technique.

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Level 4 Classes

Required Core: 3 to 4 Ballet technique classes per week, 3 Pointe classes, 1 variation/repertoire class, 1 Contemporary/Modern class, and 1-3 alignment/conditioning classes. If taking only 3 ballet classes, students MUST choose to attend Mondays, Tuesdays, and Saturdays. Optional: a fourth ballet technique class on Wednesdays. Students may add any extra classes free of additional charge to challenge themselves and improve faster. Taking additional classes at levels 1b through 3b always improves strength and technique.

School Policies

Class / Level Placement

Returning students will be provisionally placed in class based on an evaluation from the previous academic year and their summer study. However, the director/teacher has the authority to reassign a class level, following an evaluation of the student's first few classes.

New or transferring students are welcome and will take a free placement class and speak with the school's director. They will be assigned a level best suited to their ability and goals. Many factors are considered with each individual dancer. Placement is at the discretion of the artistic director.

Attendance

Regular attendance is imperative to progressing as a dancer. Please fill out the absence form (linked from our "for parents" section of the website) if your student will miss class. Students will be allowed to make-up classes at or below their level. Students with inconsistent attendance may be dismissed from their class and/or moved to another class when they cannot keep up with the syllabus as a result.

Tardiness

Students more than 15 minutes late may be asked by their teacher to sit and observe the class. It is also disrespectful to be tardy, and teaching dancers to have good class etiquette and be on time and prepared is important. Tardiness for unusual reasons is understood when it happens infrequently.

Late Pick Up Policy

All dancers must be picked up immediately at the end of their class, rehearsal, or performance. There will be a \$10 charge for every 15 minutes a student is picked up late which will be automatically charged to your account. Please email or call Emily Hill only to pre-arrange a possible late-pick up. Also, please notify us in the event of an emergency.

Make-up Classes

Students in ballet 1-6 are entitled and expected to make-up an excused absence per class in which they are registered by arranging to take a class at or below their level with the director. You may not use make-ups to enroll in a new class. No make-up classes can be used starting two weeks prior to Performance Week.
