

Tuition

\$125 per month plus \$40.00 registration fee.

All electives will be charged at the rate of: 1 Elective Hour (\$30), 2 Elective Hours (\$55), 3 Elective Hours (\$75), 4 or more Elective Hours (\$90) with the Maximum Individual Tuition Capped at \$305 (unlimited classes).

Level 1b Classes

Required Core: Tuesdays 4:30-6:30 and Thursdays 4:30-6:30 which includes 2 Ballet Technique classes, 1 Contemporary/Modern class, and 1 Repertoire Class. This is the minimum requirement for Level 1b. Ballet 1b is beginning ballet and pre-modern/lyrical technique in our level-based program. Returning students, new students, and transferring students ages 7+ are welcome in this level. Beginners ages 7-8 who do not wish to commit to the Core 1b Schedule need to instead consider taking ballet at the 1a level with or without electives. Level 1b is taken for 1-3 years before advancing based on skill. Additional, elective classes are encouraged to increase skills, coordination, and musicality, but they are not required.

Tuition

Tuition is calculated on the Hourly Tuition Schedule plus \$40.00 registration fee.

1 1-hour Class is \$55 per month

1 1-1/2-hour Class is \$75 per month

2 1-hour Classes are \$90 per month (save \$20)

3 1-hour Classes are \$125 per month (save \$40)

Level 1a Classes

This is the beginning level of ballet technique for ages 7+. Dancers who have completed Pre-Ballet A and/or B often go directly into Level 1b if they have the dedication, focus, and basic skills needed. Students must attend 4 hours a week in Level 1b. In Level 1a, dancers only have to attend one ballet class a week, although it is also strongly recommended that they take Modern A. It is a good introduction to ballet for new and returning students ages 7-8. New students ages 9-11 should begin in 1b.
